Whether you want to celebrate a special occasion or just fancy a treat, we've designed our afternoon tea menus to satisfy all tastes and sizes of appetite.



Varieties of loose leaf teas, specially selected by us, complement your afternoon tea experience.



### Traditional afternoon tea

£17.50 per person

Quintessentially a British tradition, afternoon tea was introduced by Anna 7th Duchess of Bedford in the early 1800s.

### English high tea

£25.00 per person

High tea would usually consist of cold meats, eggs or fish, cakes and sandwiches. Originally, the term “high tea” was used as a way to distinguish it from “low tea” or afternoon tea. The words ‘low’ and ‘high’ refer to the tables from which either tea meal was eaten. Low tea was served in a sitting room where low tables (like a coffee table) were placed near sofas or chairs.

### Darjeeling

A distinctive 'muscatel' flavour, with hints of blackcurrants create an almost wine like taste. Often compared to the taste and fragrance of Muscat grape.



### Earl Grey

Using only natural flavours and oils there's no aftertaste or overpowering perfume so the high quality, natural taste of the Ceylon tea we use can be enjoyed too.



### Woodfarm House Blend

A black tea blend with hints of cask oak from India, China and Kenya. Especially delicious with milk, the Assam malty flavour is enhanced by China Black Keemun Gold and a Chingwo County Orange Pekoe.



### Lovers Leap

Ceylon Earl Grey and soft Jasmine green tea combine beautifully with a blend of malty Assam, flavoursome Ceylon and Kenyan black tea.



### Fruit Berry

The combination of hibiscus, rosehip, blackcurrants, elderberries and raisins results in the most extraordinary flavours that burst through in a truly delicious berry fruit tea.



### Orange and Apple

The combination of real apple pieces, orange and herbs produces a tea that's totally caffeine free but packed with Vitamin C. Each cup bursts with flavour and goodness.



### Peppermint

Peppermint tea is a really refreshing drink, that's totally caffeine free. It tastes as good hot or cold.




### Green Tea
